Denver Public Schools Poultry Guidelines for Students and Visitors

The Managing Party will ensure that:

1. Only students older than 5 years of age are allowed to enter the chicken coop or run.
2. Only student 8 years or older are allowed to handle the chickens and/or eggs
3. Students must be supervised by a trained adult (designated by the Managing Party and trained on these standards by the Managing Party) at all times while they are in the coop, unless they are 14 years or older and properly trained and supervised by the Coop Manager.. The trained adult training will be documented complete with the date, times of training, name of trainer and information covered and this information will be shared with Denver Public Schools officials.
4. The trained adult (designated by the Managing Party and trained on these standards by the Managing Party) will ensure that children:
 - a. Will not nuzzle or kiss chickens,
 - b. Will not allow children to touch their mouths or eyes with their hands during or after contact with chickens,
 - c. And not allow children to eat or drink after visiting the coop until their hands are washed thoroughly as described above.
5. Individuals are not allowed to enter the chicken coop if they have any signs of illness, including a runny nose, cough, or nasal congestion.
6. Those who have been ill in the past week will not be allowed in the coop or run.
7. Only those who have been trained on these guidelines and have a signed Acknowledgement of Risks, Assumption of Risks and Release and Indemnity Form for Volunteers or Students will be permitted in the coop/run area will be permitted to enter the coop or run.
8. Training will be documented by the Managing Party and documentation (dates, content of training, names of those trained and trainer's name) will be shared with Denver Public Schools officials.
9. All must wash hands with soap under running water for 20 seconds before entering the coop/ run area and immediately after exiting the coop/ run area.
10. For students or volunteers to enter the coop or run area, they must wear rubber "muck" boots or disposable covers, apply hand sanitizer, and then put on disposable gloves.
11. Students or volunteers exiting the coop or run area must remove my rubber boots or disposable boot covers, throw disposable gloves in the trash outside the coop, and hands must be washed with soap and water for 20 seconds immediately after exiting the coop.
12. Nothing can be eaten or drank in the coop or run area until hands are properly washed after exiting the coop. Nothing can be placed in one's mouth nor can face or eyes be touched while in the chicken coop or run area until hands are properly washed after leaving the chicken coop or run area.
13. Eggs may not be consumed on school grounds, nor may chickens be butchered on school grounds. Those taking eggs consume them at their own risk and release DPS and the MP from all liability and harm caused by the eggs and/ or chickens.
